THTR 101--INTRODUCTION TO THEATER. How theater happens, taught with a global perspective. Video, live demos, more. No pre-req. Also counts as Clare 209. 3 Credits. Two sections: MWF 10:30-11:20 or 11:30-12:20.

THTR 301--ACTING IN ENSEMBLE. Acting in large and small scenes for stage and camera. Rehearsal and on-camera techniques, characters, on-stage partnering and more. No pre-req. 3 Credits. T/Th 10:00-11:15.

THTR 334—VOICE AND DICTION FOR THE ACTOR. Improve resonance, clarity, and stage and camera voice skills; develop voice-over characters; learn dialects and accents. No pre-req. 3 Credits. T/Th 1:00-2:15.

THTR 299---THEATER PRODUCTION. Work in SBU Theater's Fall 2015 production of Shakespeare's *Twelfth Night*, either on-stage as an actor or behind-the-scenes in lighting, sets, costumes... No pre-req.; but audition/tech interview required. 1 Credit. Rehearsals, work calls and performances as scheduled.
